**SOFA (WITH 2 PILLOWS)**

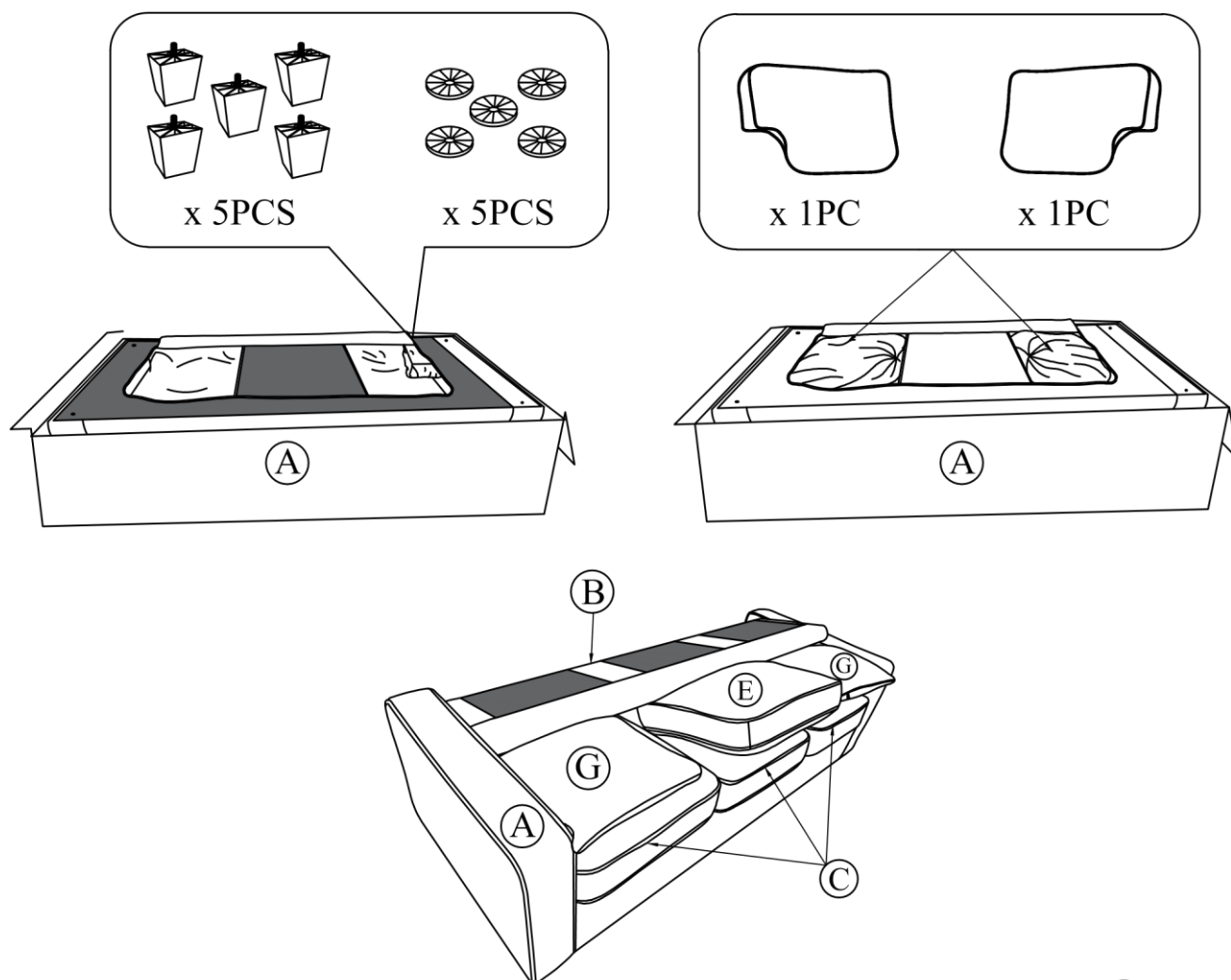


Note: Do not use power tools for assembly. Power tools increase the risk of over tightening which leads to splitting or cracking the wood.

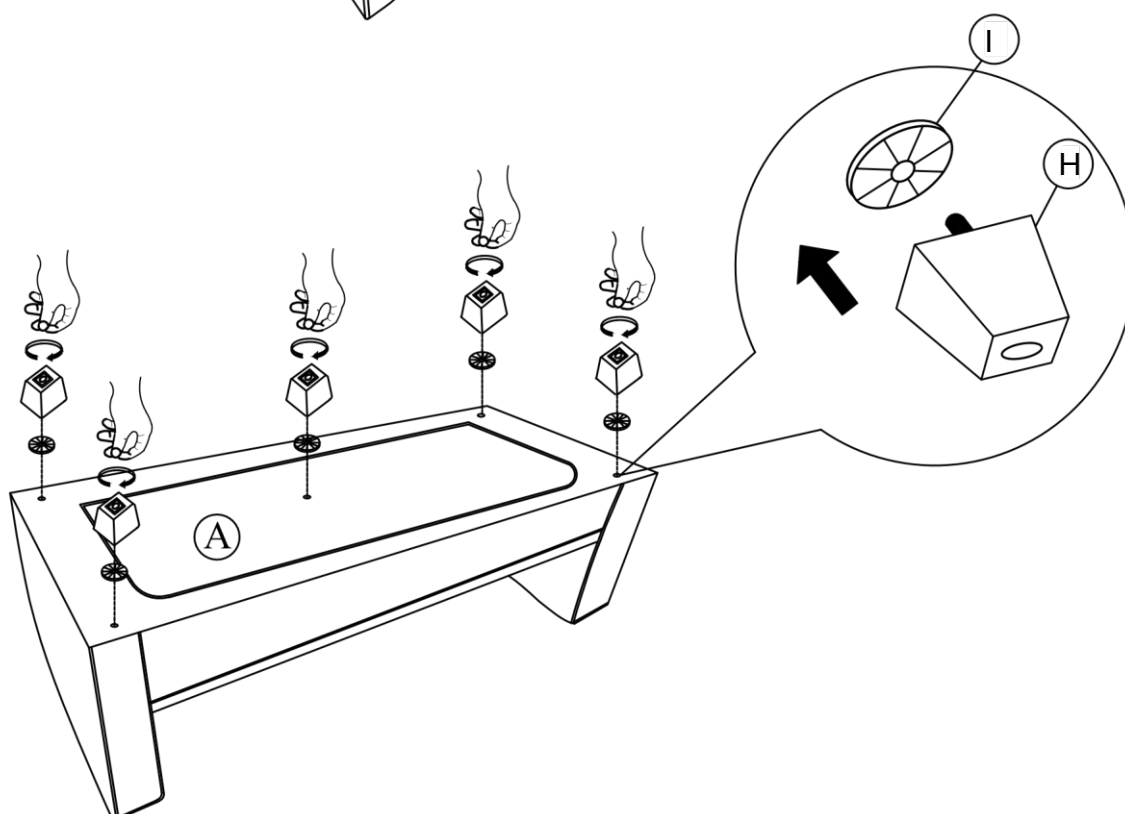

**Care Instruction for Chenille Furniture:**

**In order to maintain the original appearance of your chenille, please follow the simple care procedures below:**

- Avoid exposing furniture directly to sunlight or heating and air conditioning outlets. Sunlight and/or exposure to heating and air conditioning outlets will fade/damage chenille.
- Vacuum or wipe with a soft cloth to remove dust.
- Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically check to make sure all connections are tight. Re-tighten if necessary.



**For items used on wooden floor, hard surfaces or carpets, it is recommended to install protective pads under all legs and supports to prevent damages, scratches, and discoloration.**
